But if you want to get away from the golf tournament for a sandwich and pie -- walk to **McKinley's Fine Bakery and Cafe**.

McKinley's replaced a franchise bakery tucked into the southwest corner of University Park Village. If you used to go to one of the other bakeries or cafes nearby, you'll find the same wide menu of sandwiches, salads and quiche, plus first-rate desserts.

Lunch one recent day was a credible beef-sausage lasagna. But the genuine highlight was a classic strawberry icebox pie.

The menu also features other hot-plate lunches and sandwiches (\$6-\$9), plus pancake breakfasts on Saturday mornings.

Dutch's, a modern burger grill in an old college hangout, has also added shakes and malts to go with classic burgers, sliders and onion rings.
